

PocketPigskin® Installation for Pocket PC 2009 Edition

Installing

The ActiveSync program should be running, and your device powered on and connected through the USB cable. ActiveSync is a Microsoft PDA application; it can be found in the Start menu or in the Program Files folder under Microsoft ActiveSync.

- 1) To remove previous versions and reclaim memory on the device refer to the *Removing Previous Installations* section below.
- 2) Select the Pocket PC installer link on the chosen team's download web page.
- 3) When prompted, select Open to execute the installer. Alternatively, save the installer file to the computer desktop, then double-click on the EXE file to start the installation process.
- 4) Set the destination folder (the default is C:\Program Files\PocketPigskin\PocketPC-142), then select the Install button.
- 5) If prompted by Add/Remove Programs, check the box for "SuperWaba VM". Select OK, and okay the prompts on the device and the computer. Select Yes for an unknown publisher prompt.
- 6) If prompted by Add/Remove Programs, check the box for "SuperWaba PocketPigskin" (do not uncheck SuperWaba VM). Select OK, and okay the prompts on the device and the computer.
- 7) Select the checkboxes of the documents to open when the installer exits.
- 8) Select the Close button to complete the installation, and open the selected documents.

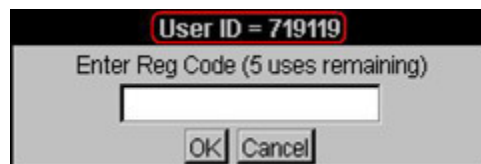
The PocketPigskin® application may be installed manually if the automated installation did not succeed. Refer to the *Installing Manually* section below.

Running on the Pocket PC

- 9) Select the PocketPigskin® icon in the Programs folder of the Start Menu to run the application.
- 10) Add the PocketPigskin® application as a Start menu selection by checking the box in the Menus (Start > Settings > Personal > Menus).

Registering

- 11) When you first run the PocketPigskin® application it will prompt you to register your product.



Contact support@pocketpigskin.com with the User ID provided in the start up prompt (719119 in this example) to get your registration code. The PocketPigskin® application will not allow searches, editing, nor saving changes until registered. After the use count reaches zero the PocketPigskin® application will prompt for the registration code, and then exit if a valid code is not entered.

Troubleshooting

- a) Go to the SWVM directory in the Program Files folder on the device and select the SuperWaba.exe icon; the welcome screen should appear.
- b) Go to the PocketPigskin directory in the SWVM folder and select the PocketPigskin.exe icon. If the application runs from here the shortcut in the Start Menu may be the problem.
- c) Pocket PC / Windows CE / Windows Mobile PDAs come in a variety of configurations. Most devices will run with CAB files provided, however there are some devices that require different sets of files. The good news is we have those files and will be happy to provide the configuration needed for your device. Please provide details on your Pocket PC device.

Removing Previous Installations

- a) If the PocketPigskin® application is a Start menu selection, uncheck the box in the Menus (Start > Settings > Personal > Menus).
- b) Delete the earlier version of the PocketPigskin® installation using Remove Programs (Start > Settings > System > Remove Programs).
- c) Delete the earlier version of SuperWaba using Remove Programs (Start > Settings > System > Remove Programs).
- d) Delete any remaining files by removing the SuperWaba folder in the “My Device” directory (Start > Programs > File Explorer).
 - Note: the new version will be installed in the “Program Files” directory on the Pocket PC.

Installing Manually

- a) Open ActiveSync and establish a partnership. A "guest" partnership is sufficient since we are only transferring files; it is not necessary to synchronize the PDA with your personal information management (PIM) applications.
- b) Select the Explore button in ActiveSync to bring up a Window on your computer that shows your Pocket PC device directories.
- c) Open the "My Windows Mobile-Based Device" icon in the explorer window.
- d) Copy the "waba" CAB file from installation folder on the computer to Pocket PC device.
- e) Using the file explorer on the device (Start > Programs > File Explorer), navigate to the “My Device” folder (top-most level of directory hierarchy).
- f) Install the CAB file by selecting the CAB icon on the Pocket PC device. If prompted to overwrite previous installations select OK.
- g) Copy the "PocketPigskin" CAB file from the installation folder on the computer to Pocket PC device.
- h) Install the CAB file by selecting the CAB icon on the Pocket PC device. If prompted to overwrite previous installations select OK.
- i) Refer to the *Running on the Pocket PC* section.
- j) If necessary, refer to the “Troubleshooting” section.
