

PocketPigskin® Installation for Windows 2009 Edition

Installing

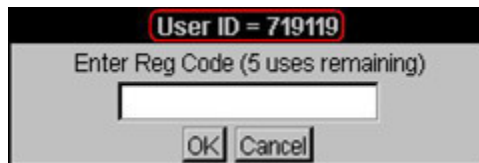
- 1) Select the Windows installer link on the chosen team's download web page.
- 2) When prompted, select Open to execute the installer. Alternatively, save the installer file to the computer desktop, then double-click on the EXE file to start the installation process.
- 3) Set the destination folder (the default is C:\Program Files\PocketPigskin\Windows-142), then select the Install button.
- 4) Select the checkboxes of the documents to open when the installer exits. Note the option to run the PocketPigskin® application immediately after the installation is completed!
- 5) Select the Close button to complete the installation, and open the selected components.

Running on Windows

- 6) Start the application using the shortcut in Start > Programs > PocketPigskin.

Registering

- 7) When you first run the PocketPigskin® application it will prompt you to register your product.



Contact support@pocketpigskin.com with the User ID provided in the start up prompt (719119 in this example) to get your registration code. The PocketPigskin® application will not allow searches, editing, nor saving changes until registered. After the use count reaches zero the PocketPigskin® application will prompt for the registration code, and then exit if a valid code is not entered.

Troubleshooting

- If Windows Vista has set the file properties as read-only when the files were installed select the top-level PocketPigskin folder and change them back to read-write. Select the folder with a left mouse click, then a right mouse click and select Properties. Uncheck the read-only attribute and apply the change to all files and sub-folders.
- Go to the PocketPigskin folder in the installation directory and double-click the SuperWaba.exe file; the welcome screen should appear.
